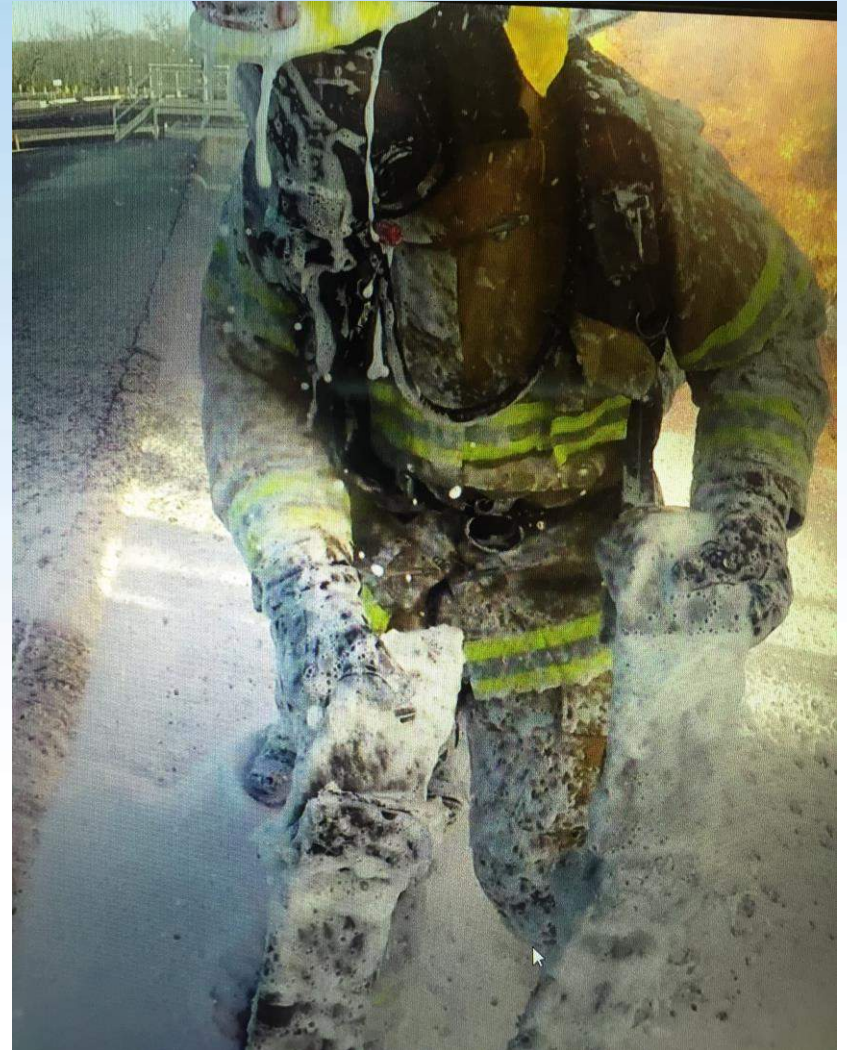

SDG&E's Fire Coordination Team

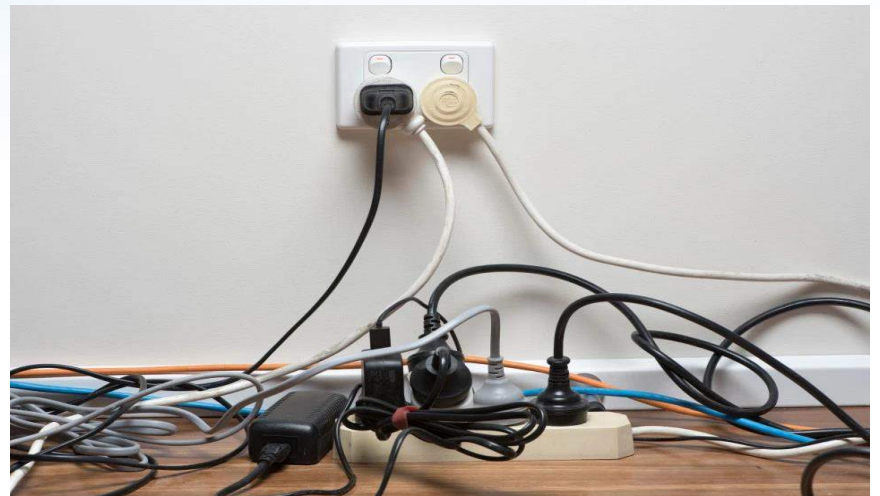
- Trains the fire departments within the SDG&E service territory

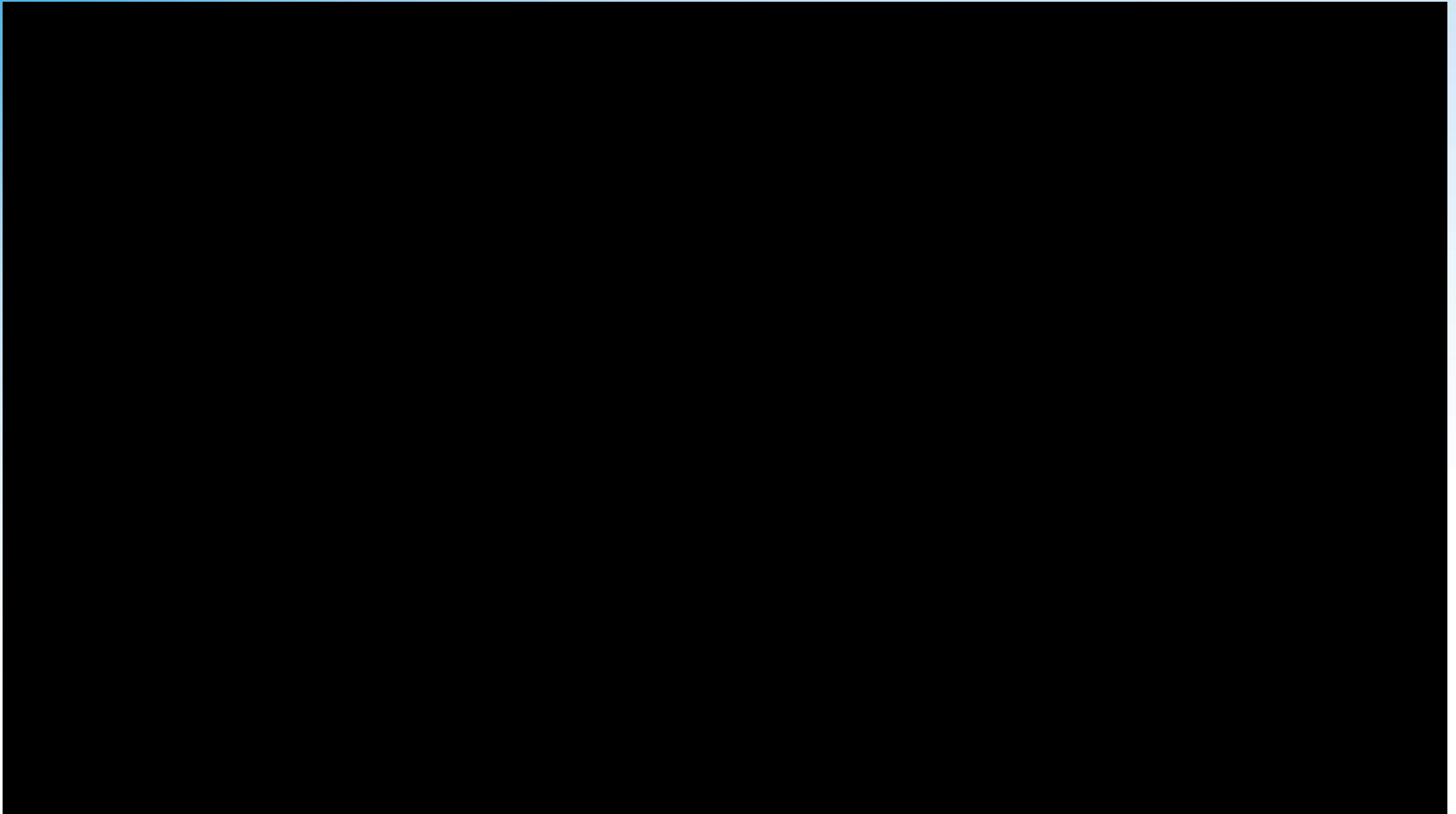

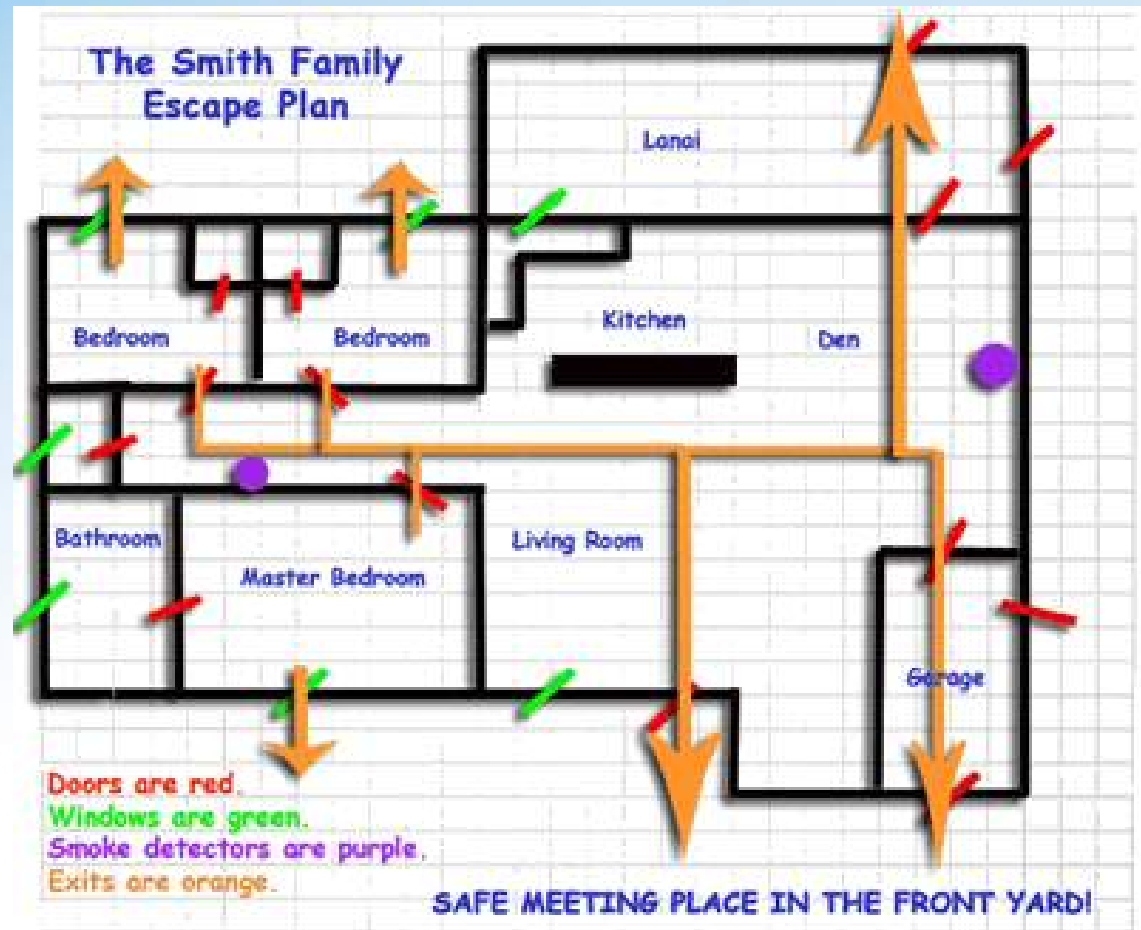

Home Evacuation during a fire

- Smoke Detectors and CO2 alarms should be checked regularly
- All members of the family should know the primary and secondary meet up points
- If the adults of the house aren't around who do your kids contact?
- Don't hide from the firefighters



Firefighter Tactics

Rescue

Exposures

Containment

Extinguishment

Community Evacuation

- In many cases having a plan and making sure everyone knows what that plan is are different things
- Important Factors to consider:
 - What would happen if there was an evacuation and you weren't home?
 - Do you have an emergency kit?
 - Is your meet up location realistic?
 - Which car are you taking? Does it have enough gas to get you where you need to go?



Adapt and Overcome

- **As much as we plan, and as good as we think our plans are, inevitably something will happen that will alter the plan.**
- **If you had 30 minutes to evacuate:**
- **What would you take?**
- **How would you bring those items?**
- **If you have kids, how long would it take to load them up?**
- **If you have pets, do you have food and water ready?**



Summary

- Prepare
 - Take the steps to put yourself in a situation where you can succeed
- Prevent
 - Do what you can to prevent an incident in the first place
- Adapt
 - Have a plan but be ready to adapt as needed
