OK, But Watch Out for LSD, that is, Lead Singer's Disease!






So, challenge yourself, get out front. Even the best get knocked around some.

You'll be OK.




You: Be Able to Play the Coffee House and the Arena

Music is full of disrupters...








Or...

The Message and Collaborators (M & C)

- Who remembers "Thank You Girl?"








So, what have you done that's A-side work? Or, what will you do?


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
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
M & C: Be Bernie Taupin...

Beth? Living on a Prayer? Open Arms?


Develop Your "Softer" Side
