



Physically removes the hazard

Replaces the hazard

Isolates workers from the hazard

Communicates the hazard

Changes the way the work is performed



- Easy to forget or not know that the other controls have already been applied








### How Do We Fix It?

- Can cause domino effects


#### Be Personal
