# WHAT IS CPTED?

- ***Proper Design, Effective Use of the built environment- reduced fear and incidents***
- What is “proper design”?
- The main emphasis of CPTED that helps reduce crime and create safer spaces by focusing on:
  - Physical environment
  - Behavior of people
  - Productive use of space



The goal of CPTED is to reduce opportunities for crime that may be inherent in the design of the structures or in the design of the neighborhoods.

## **Electronic**


Often referred to as mechanical: consists of alarms, cameras, fencing, etc.


## **Organizational**

Best known as security officers but can be simplified to people.


## **Architectural**

Known as “natural security, which is the greatest emphasis in CPTED.





# NATURAL SURVEILLANCE



NS increases criminal apprehension by taking steps to increase the perception that people can be seen.

Emphasis on strategic placement of people, activities, and features.




- Make entrances obvious




